VILLAGE : JULLIE (Rhône)

PLACE : « Les Roberts » - « La Roche »

SURFACE : 5 HA

PLANTING DENSITY: 10 000 pieds/HA

AVERAGE AGE: 40 years old

YIELD : 52 HL/HA according to AOC prescripts

TERRAIN : Granitic shale

VARIETAL: Gamay – Goblet pruning

ORIGIN: A section of this vineyard is next to the Château de La Roche belonging to Madame La Marquise de Fayolle. We acquired it in 1988.

WINEMAKING: Manual harvest. Traditional semi-carbonic winemaking of whole berries with temperature control. Raised in vats after the malolactic fermentation.

WINE PERSONALITY : Charming bright red color, with red berries aroma, tannic and structured, honest in the mouth, ending with a mineral note. It can be called a Beaujolais-Villages fit for ageing. To drink within 3 years

OUR WINETASTING SUGGESTIONS: Drink cool (14°C/ 57°F). An easy to drink, refreshing wine perfect with cold cuts, grilled meat and aged
