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Appellation SAINT-AMOUR

Sustainable winegrowing with partial, controlled grass cover

VILLAGE: SAINT-AMOUR (Saône-et-Loire)

PLACE: « Les Capitans »

SURFACE: 0.90 HA

DENSITY: 10 000 vines/HA

AVERAGE AGE: 35 years

YIELD: 52 HL/HA per AOC regulations

SOIL: sandy clay soil

VARIETAL: Gamay – Goblet pruning

ORIGIN: Transmitted from father to son since 3 generations.

WINEMAKING: Manual harvest. Traditional semi-carbonic winemaking with immersed cap and temperature control. Raised in vats after malo-lactic fermentation. 17 days maceration.

WINE PERSONALITY: Ruby color with violet hue. To the nose, red berries aromas, blackcurrant, with a hint of liquorice. Fruity in mouth, supple, refined. Long lasting. Can age 5 to 8 years.

OUR WINETASTING SUGGESTIONS: Drink cool (14°) in its first year, then just below room temperature (17°) once it has begun to age. Perfect with white meat and chicken.
